Village of Youngstown Board of Trustees Work Session Minutes– October 25, 2018

The Board will be looking at space in the Village Center during this work session. Prior to viewing the space, Trustee Zastrow commented that he felt with the bank now gone, the Clerk's Office should offer notary services to the residents. Clerk-Treasurer Brown advised the Clerk's Office does offer notary services, as well as the Town of Porter. Discussion continued amongst the Board. It was brought to the Board's attention, now that it is dark, on Board meeting nights, you can see in the windows in the front of the building. The view seems to be of clutter against the windows. The space is currently occupied by the Library. They will be cleaning the space as the Board approved the capping of the toilet and sink area in that space. If after the transition the view is not better a suggestion of curtains on the windows was offered.

VILLA CONDOMINIUM

GREENWAY FUNDS
